Independent workspaces . . .

★ **Members** – second floor studio only

Members may have access to the Second Floor Studio for a maximum of 15 hours a week when Hinckley Pottery is open and no classes or workshops are scheduled for the space (an estimated 40 hours per week). This is a common space meant to be shared with others; it is not designed for production pottery. Storage of pots and supplies is limited to the number of shelves rented. Glazing of pots is done in the glaze area on the first floor. During class times, glazing space may be limited.

Fee: \$185 per month for two shelves (36x18 each)

- An initial payment of one month's rent plus a deposit equal to one month's rent is required. Additional shelves may be rented for \$90 per month per shelf if available. Private instruction can be scheduled.
- Requires a written agreement as well as an understanding of studio operations and safety and security measures.
- Requires purchase of a clay package. Outside clay is not permitted, but specific high fire clay bodies may be requested.

Clay package: \$75 for stoneware, \$90 for porcelain

Covers 50 pounds of clay plus glazing and firing. Pots 8 inches or more in size at the bisque stage will require firing tickets for glaze firing. The clay package fee covers glazes but does not cover under- and over-glazes and other additions.

★ **Residents** – upstairs

Each space is 6' x 8' and includes two 36" x 18" x 72" shelving units. Requires the purchase of a clay package (see above). No outside clay is permitted, but specific high-fire clay bodies may be requested. The resident provides wheel, tools, furniture and other supplies.

Fees:

For 3 months - \$285/month + clay/glaze/firing package

For 6 months - \$275/month + clay/glaze/firing package

For 12 months - \$265/month + clay/glaze/firing package

- The minimum rental term for a resident space is three months.
- An advance payment of first month's rent and one-month deposit is required on signing.
- A written agreement is required as well as an understanding of studio operations and of safety and security measures.

Our main classroom offers classes and open studio times.

✧ **Class fees**

Fee: \$400 per 10-week session. The fee covers clay, glazing and firing, except for pots 8 inches or more in size at the bisque stage. Glaze firing tickets are required for those larger pots. One shelf is provided for each class session.

✧ **Open studio** for current students only

Fee: \$5 per hour (measured in full hour increments)

Available in the first-floor studio for currently enrolled students when classes are not scheduled and Hinckley Pottery is open. There is a monitor but no instruction and no additional shelf space. Additional shelves can be rented by the month. Open studio hours are posted on our website at http://www.hinckleypottery.com/schedule_open_studio.htm

✧ **Extra class time**

Fee: \$40 per class

Currently enrolled students may take additional classes in any regularly scheduled class that has space available.

✧ **Extra shelf** rental for students – limited availability

Fee: \$50 per month payable in advance

• Downstairs for regular students • upstairs only for students in special classes
Temp shelves are available but for limited use. Those who regularly use all or most of a temp shelf may be asked to rent an extra shelf.

✧ **Private instruction** with Jill Hinckley or another instructor is available.
